From the Chief Engineer, (Panchayati Raj) Letter.No.552/M/70, dated: 7.10.1971.

ORDER:

The chief Engineer, (panchayati Raj) had been representing quite for some time now, that the existing staff in the Panchayati Raj Engineering Department is not commensurate with the work load it is entrusted with from time to time and that with the addition of special programmes like Rural works programme, crash programme for Development works etc. with considerable difficulties this year, the work load has increased very much which the existing staff are unable to cope with. He has requested that in order to implement the various schemes satisfactorily and in order not to allow the funds to lapse absolutely minimum additional staff commensurate with the Government's economy drive at the circle, Division and State level might be sanctioned.

2. Government after careful consideration of the proposals, sanction the creation of one circle, 5 districts, 37 sub divisions and 103 sections in the panchayati Raj Engineering Department with the staff indicated in annexure I to this order with immediate effect.

3. Government also sanction additional staff to the offices of the Chief Engineer, (Panchayati Raj) and the Office of the Director/Intending Engineer, (Panchayati Raj), go Eluru, Guntur and Hyderabad as indicated in annexure IV and V to this order with immediate effect.

4. The sanction accorded in para 2 and 3 above is upto 28.2.72.

5. The expenditure on the staff sanctioned in para 2 and 3 above should be debited to the following heads of account:-

- i) " 50 Public works - (C) Establishment & (ii) Local Administration Engineering Services".
- ii) "50. Public works (C) Establishment - (iii) Local Administration Engineering Service".
- iii) "50. Public works (C) Grants-in-aid & Grants to Zilla Parishads towards establishment charges."

6. As the provisions made in the Budget Estimates for 1971-72 under the above heads of account are not sufficient, action will be taken separately to provide funds either by way of re-appropriation from out of savings within the grant or by making a supplementary grant at the appropriate time. The Chief Engineer (Panchayati Raj) is requested to send necessary proposals accordingly for the approval of Government.

He has requested that in order to implement the various schemes satisfactorily and in order not to allow the funds to lapse absolutely minimum additional staff commensurate with the Government's economy drive at the circle, Division and State level might be sanctioned.

2. Government after careful consideration of the proposals, sanction the creation of one circle, 5 divisions, 37 sub divisions and 125 sections in the Panchayati Raj Engineering Department with the staff indicated in annexure I to L.I.F. to this order with immediate effect.
